They reared four children who attended the local schools. Sally misses kids playing outside, the Beach Parades and adult volleyball games in a neighbor's yard and at the beach. As many as 300 kids knocked on their door on Halloween. Families living on Aquarina and Shoals had as many as 5 and 6 kids. How things have changed.

**Rich Kniffel**, bike rider, lives on Embarcadero with his wife, Joan. They are original owners in the sub's 2<sup>nd</sup> phase. Rich started a water ski club in '60 or '61 called the Ski Demons, now the oldest ski club in MI. Members entered local, state and regional competition. They flew and crashed a ski kite several times. In the winter some of the of the men would put visqueen and sand on the ice. During the spring thaw the sand would float to the bottom to create the sandy swim area we have today. With Mitch Sieoma he hosted beach sleepovers for kids and served them buckwheat pancakes in the am. The big bar-b-q pit was central to the Saturday night steak cook-outs. Rich water-skied the lake for some 40 years. Joan babysat some 500 children over the years. Rich and Joan reared 3 children here.
