**Expeditor's News** - There will be **boat storage for LOHA members** in the beach parking lot **this winter** on a first come basis. The <u>cost is \$120.00</u> for each watercraft stored. The check is written to LOHA. A separate form for each watercraft must be filled out. A <u>valid current copy of insurance</u> must be submitted for each item with each <u>Boat Storage Application</u>. The <u>MC# must be visible on the outside of the watercraft's cover</u>, and written in permanent ink on a tarp or shrink-wrap. **Forms must be submitted with payment before storage**. Gail and Jerry Chamberlain have lived on Levee since 1986. Gail lived on Mariner from '57 to '69. Her Dad, Cliff Woods now 84 & living in NM, helped build homes on Aguarina and Shoals & later poured the basements on other streets. Cliff also helped build the boat dock in '57. Tree trunks from the lot were used for the vertical supports. He reported that there was a hill, which was leveled to make the beach area. In '69 Gail moved to Colorado and then Germany. For 2 years before buying the Baker home on Levee, Gail bugged the Bakers, whom she knew were due to retire. It paid off. Gail & Jerry wanted to rear their daughter in a neighborhood with sidewalks, neighbors out walking and of course the amenities of a lake. At one time LOHA held beauty pageants for the young girls who modeled in their bathing suits. Gail remembers walking daily to Federal Dept. store and Kresge's, that were located where Dunham's and the Dollar Store are now. She also talked about running down to the beach and hiding in the cement cylinders when she was upset as a child. Today you will find the Chamberlains at the beach with their 5-year old granddaughter Camden, who loves the water. Their 7month old grandson loves the baby swing. Recently Gail wrote a letter for all LOHA residents to read. "Dear LOHA Residents, we would like to give a big THANK YOU to Pam Pope, Sharon Gwin, Lynn Woolslayer, Carolyn Bree and everyone who put in time on the Family Fun Day Activities, the weekend of Aug. 8 & 9. There was torrential rain and extreme heat, but all of the participants had a great time. Having been involved in planning and executing these types of events through church, work and school, we appreciate the amount of work and time it takes to make these festivities successful.
