Beach Attendant & Weenie Shack Concession Position(s) Open for 2014

Attention: L.O.H.A. Members

Our longtime beach guard and Weenie Shack operator, Lynn Woolslayer has decided to take a sabbatical for the 2014 season, so we are in need of a beach guard and anyone who may wish to operate the Weenie Shack. Applicants should be 21 years of age or older and be a member of L.O.H.A.

The hourly rate of payment for beach guard is \$8.00 per hour with a maximum number of hours per week of 40. Duties include checking people at the beach to make sure they are either members or quests, clearing the boardwalks of debris, emptying trash, sweeping pavilion, letting members use the games equipment such as volleyball, badminton racquets horseshoes etc., keeping track of beach equipment & supplies, etc. Hours are flexible according to need and weather, but normally will require working most weekends and during L.O.H.A. events.

The operation of the Weenie Shack can be done by the beach guard or by another person. This person will act as an independent contractor and will retain all profits from the sale of any items. Any items sold do have to be approved by L.O.H.A. They normally include hot dogs, corn dogs, candy bars, ice crème, pop, water, etc. The operator can set their own hours, but normally would be expected to be open on weekends and some weekdays during the summer, depending on weather and attendance.
