BOAT LAUNCH LOCK AND KEYS

Starting in 2015, there will be a new lock installed at the boat launch ramp. If you wish to utilize the boat launch, you must thus obtain a new key. We are currently having new keys made, which should be ready soon.

If you currently have a boat launch key, you can exchange it for a new key at no cost, providing you are a current member in good standing of L.O.H.A.

If you are applying for a new key without having a current one, you may do so at a cost of \$ 30.00, again, providing you are a current L.O.H.A. member.

The new keys will be numbered, so, at the time the new key is issued, the number will be recorded under the name of the member who receives it. At the time you pick up your new key, you will be required to verify your current membership, address and contact information and provide information regarding your current watercraft.

The Policy for Guests, Beach & Pavilion Use Has Changed Effective 2015 L.O.H.A. GUEST RULES

- 1. A member must accompany non-member guests at L.O.H.A. Park at all times.
- 2. The member hosting non-member guests will be responsible for the guests following all of the beach rules and regulations, especially the rule not allowing glass beverage containers on the premises.
- 3. A member (household) is allowed to have a total of six non-member guests in the park area at any one time without payment of any additional fees.
- 4. For any and all non-member guests, exceeding six, there will be a fee of \$ 2.00 per guest.
- 5. Payment for more than six non-member guests should be made to the beach guard on the date the guests are present at the Park. It is up to the member and the beach guard to agree upon the number of non-member guests for whom the \$ 2.00 fee shall be paid.
- 6. Under no circumstances will any one member or household use more than one-half of the pavilion to accommodate guests on any given date.
- 7. Tables outside the pavilion will not be moved inside the pavilion to accommodate quests.
- 8. Guests may be directed to park in the extra lot at the discretion of the beach guard.
- 9. L.O.H.A. reserves the right to limit the total number of guests allowed in the Park area on any given date. Thus it is important that a member notifies L.O.H.A. if they intend to have over 20 guests at the Park on any given date. This is intended to protect both the interests of L.O.H.A. and the members and guests.
- 10. The beach guard has the authority to request that any guest or member leaves the premises for unruly behavior or failure to adhere to the beach rules and regulations and, if necessary, to contact the proper authorities if any person fails to comply.
