Again, we will only allow winter boat storage for members in the beach parking lot. We will attempt to deliver boat storage forms to all the members who stored their boats last year. Anyone who does not receive a form can obtain one from Lee Howell. (673-8989) or Jerry Chamberlain (673-8148). The fee for storage will remain at \$120.00. You must submit a completed form and payment to either, prior to or at the time of storage. You must identify your boat by writing your name and/or MC Number on the outer covering of your storage wrap. Any boats found stored in the parking lot that cannot be identified or the owner has not paid & submitted the form will be towed. Boats must be removed from the lot by May 1st, 2016. Any member who knowingly violates the above stipulations will not be allowed to store his/her boat the following year.
