#### **INCREASE IN DUES**

Dues will be increased by \$3.00 across the board, which means that Regular Dues will be \$72.00 and Senior Dues will be \$58.00. There has been no increase since 2007. Checks are to be paid to LOHA and dropped off to Jessica Baker at 3755 Breaker.

### **PAYMENTS TO LOHA**

As determined by the Board Members a couple of years ago, all payments are to be made by check. That means that the membership dues, boat dues, boat storage fees, and extra guest fees <u>MUST be Paid by CHECK</u>. This makes the Treasure's job easier. Money orders are also acceptable.

### **SEAWALL STONES**

The stones along the outer edge of the seawall are called Riprap or Toe Stone, and are required by the DEQ as part of the seawall construction. The Department of Environmental Quality would not give final approval for the seawall unless these are present. This supposedly is to help maintain fish and other aquatic habitat, such as crayfish, minnows, etc., as well as add support to the seawall. With the old wood seawall, there were a lot of crayfish up under the wall and these stones are the kind of habitat they use for breeding. No riprap was placed directly in front of the sand beach area of the wall. We urge the members not to move these stones, as the DEQ may inspect periodically and if they are not present, we may have to pay to have more brought in. Lee Howell, President
