## 🔔 WINTER BOAT STORAGE 🕹

Winter boat storage at the beach will be \$150 per watercraft this year.

Due to township ordinances, we are unable to accept applications for storage spots until October 1, 2022. Waterford Township has mandated certain provisions in order for them to continue to allow us to store boats at the beach.

One of those mandates is that the storage period must be within the time period of October 1-April 30. Also, we can have a maximum of only 25 boats stored in any one season. If either of those mandates is violated, they can invalidate the agreement and not allow us to store any boats at all. Any boats left at the beach outside of that period will be removed. All paperwork for storage is available by contacting Boating Director Shawn Knedgen at (248) 804-4060.
