- 2. ELECTION of NEW BOARD 2023-2024

<u>Winter boat storage</u> at the beach will be \$150.00 per watercraft this year. Due to township ordinances, we are unable to accept applications for storage spots until October 1, 2023. A check for \$150.00 made out to LOHA <u>MUST</u> be included with the application to reserve a spot. Put boat storage on memo line.

To continue to allow us to store boats at the beach, the Township mandated that the storage period must be within the time period of October 1 - April 30. Also, we can only have a maximum of 25 boats that can be stored in any one season. If either of those mandates are violated, it can invalidate the agreement, and not allow us to store any boats at all. Any boats left at the beach outside of that period will be removed.
