New Business

4. Community Center Bond Issue – Don Swanson presented information about an information night on Oct. 7 at 6:30pm at the Waterford Rec Center at 5640 Willams Lake Rd. The Waterford Township is looking for vote support to purchase 3 buildings on the Highland OCC Campus for a Community Center. Programs at Legget School and the CIA will move to the new site. The property backs Hess Hathaway Park. The cost of the Bond Issue for 20 years is \$36,000,000.00. The cost to homeowners would be between \$4.00 and \$5.00 a year.
